**NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY IN SUPPORT OF
MOTION TO STAY DISCOVERY [ECF NO. 39]**

Defendants submit this notice of supplemental authority in support of their Motion to Stay Discovery [ECF No. 39]. Last week, another court in this district granted an Opposed Motion to Stay Proceedings in a similar challenge to several local jurisdictions' large-capacity magazine and assault weapon restrictions. *Rocky Mountain Gun Owners v. Town of Superior*, Minute Order, No. 22-cv-02680-NYW-TPO (D. Colo. Aug. 28, 2026), *attached as* Exhibit A. The Order is relevant to Defendants' argument that a stay is warranted because the Supreme Court's forthcoming decisions in *Viramontes v. Cook County*, No. 25-238 (U.S.) and *Grant v. Higgins*, No. 25-566 (U.S.), are "likely to provide critical guidance in a hotly contested area that will significantly affect discovery in this case" at pages 10-12 of Defendants' Motion. It also adds to the list of cases stayed pending *Viramontes* and *Grant* at Page 11 of Defendants' Motion.
