CONSENT MOTION TO CONTINUE STATUS HEARING

The United States of America, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully files this Consent Motion to Continue the Status Hearing in the above-captioned matter, currently scheduled for May 10, 2021 until a date after July 6, 2021. In support thereof, the government states as follows:

1. On January 18, 2021, the defendant was arrested and charged by Criminal Complaint with one count of Obstruction, in violation of Unlawful Entry on Capitol Grounds, violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1752(a)(1) and (4). On February 9, 2021, the Honorable Judge Meriweather ordered that the defendant remain on release subject to monitoring conditions. A preliminary hearing was set for March 8, 2021, the defendant waived the hearing. A status hearing was set for April 7, 2021 and continued until may 10, 2021.
2. The government and counsel for the defendant have conferred and are continuing to communicate in an effort to resolve this matter. The government is also gathering discovery to provide to counsel for the defendant.
3. The parties, therefore, would respectfully request that the status hearing be continued
