Earlier today, Plaintiff filed two draft resolutions that had been provided to members of the Center’s Board this past weekend for potential consideration at the Board meeting scheduled for September 15, 2026. *See* Doc. 75; Doc. 75-1; Doc. 75-2. Today, Joe LaFauci, the Center’s Vice President of Board Relations, informed the Board that, “[d]ue to the recently exacerbated structural emergencies,” tomorrow’s meeting “is now focused exclusively on the necessary closure of the Center.” *See* Exhibit A at 1.
