**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 21st day of May, 2024, upon consideration of Defendant Federal Trade Commission's ("FTC") letter request for a one-week extension to respond to Plaintiff ATS Tree Services, LLC's ("ATS") preliminary injunction motion, and good cause appearing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Defendant's request for extension to respond is **GRANTED**. It is further **ORDERED**<sup>1</sup> as follows:

1. The FTC shall file its response in opposition to ATS's Motion for Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 10) on or by **June 4, 2024**;
2. ATS shall file its reply in support of its Motion on or by **June 25, 2024**;
3. Should the Court deem a hearing on ATS's Motion necessary, a tentative hearing date is scheduled for **July 10, 2024 at 12:00 p.m.**;
